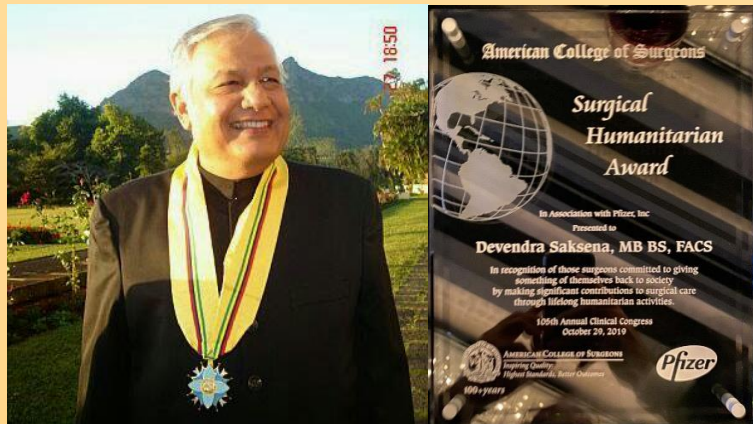

Dr S V Khadilkar was awarded the “**Dronacharya Award**” for his long-term contribution to neurology education.

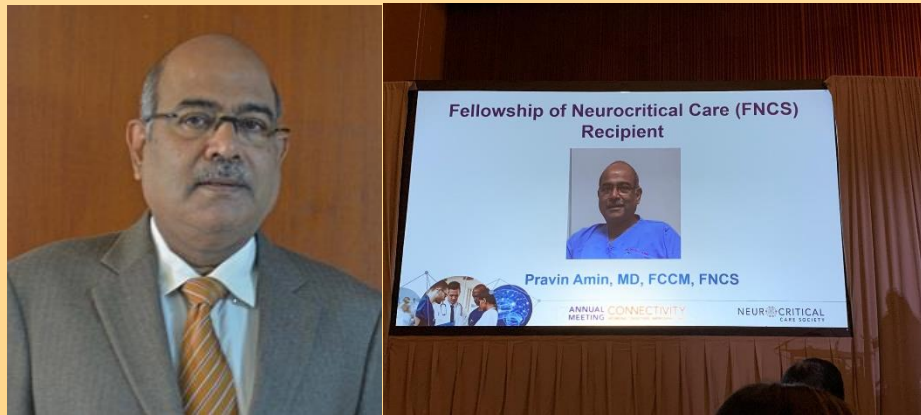

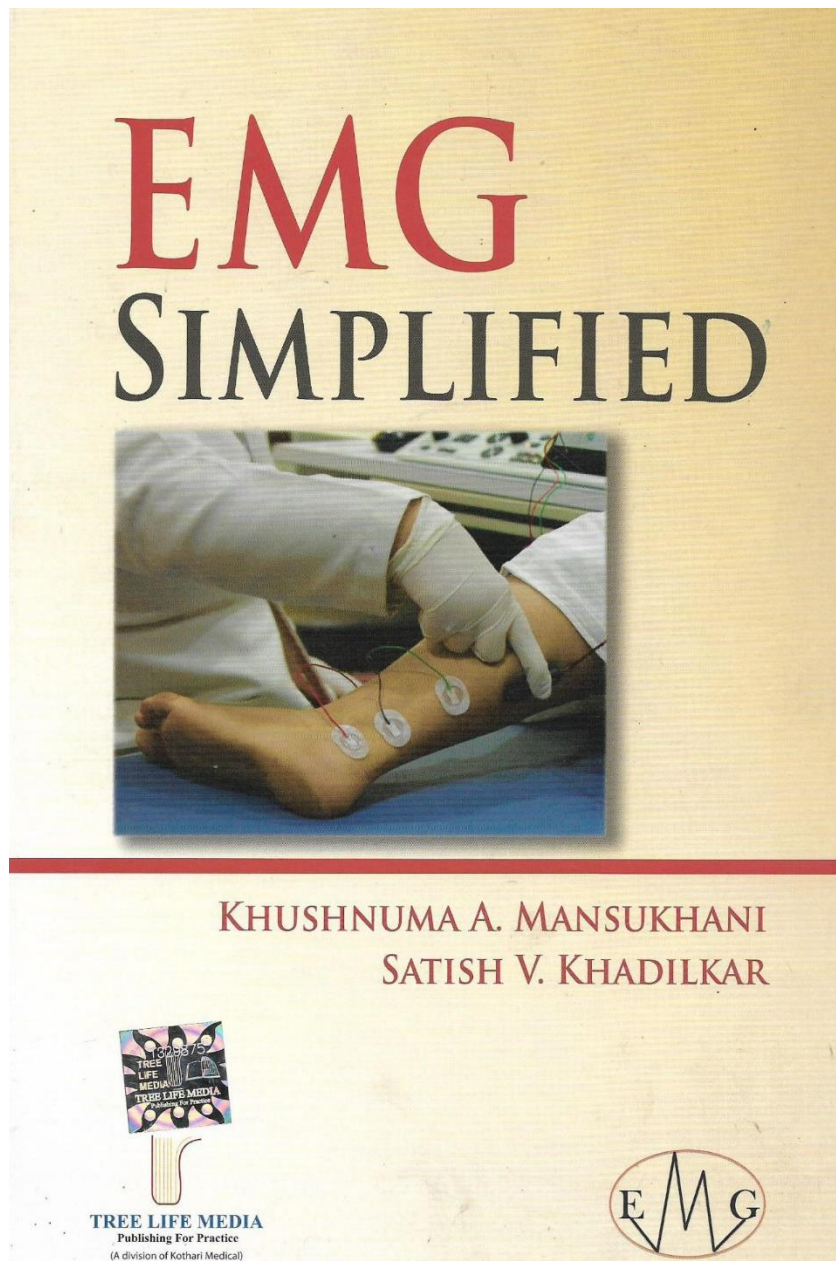

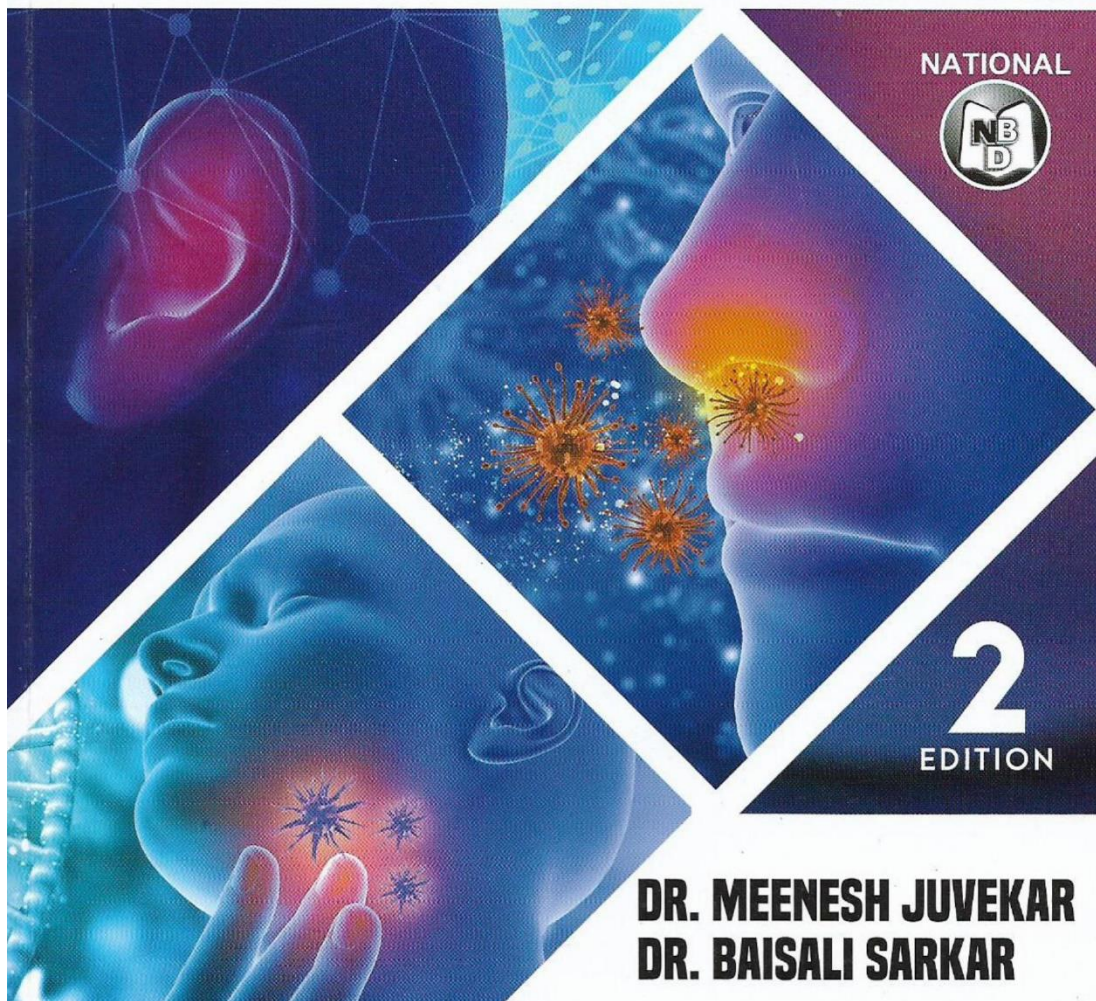

## New Happening at BHIMS

### Dr. Nupur Kapoor Nerurkar

- ❖ The “**Bombay Hospital Voice and Swallowing Center**” has been established as a specialty independent department in Bombay Hospital in 2018. This is probably one of the first few such departments established in India to date.
- ❖ Dr. Nupur Nerurkar is Program Director of the Laryngology Fellowship Program at Bombay Hospital, which was started in 2007 and, is the first one in the City. We have trained over 30 fellows to date who are practicing both in India and Abroad in UAE and UK.

### Cutting edge surgeries

- ❖ Transoral Laser Microlaryngeal Cordectomy (TLMC) is offered as an option to all early glottic cancer patients, which is a modality to treat early vocal fold cancer without radiation/chemotherapy as a minimally invasive laser procedure with a 1-2 day stay in hospital.
- ❖ Feminization surgery to raise the pitch of the voice of a transperson by anterior web creation is another minimally invasive and specialized surgery offered at BHVSC.

- ❖ Recently, Dr. Nene started a Lung Transplant OPD at Bombay Hospital, perhaps the only lung transplant OPD in the city.
